Library Catalogue or Discovery Research?

Use the **Library Catalogue** to find books, ebooks, journal titles, audio visual and media resources and to keep up to date with new material received by the Library.

Use **Discovery** to search simultaneously across multiple databases including the Library catalogue, digital repository, ebook collections and journal databases. Discovery will offer pathways that will link you to full text resources.

Borrowing, Renewals and Limits

You can borrow up to 100 items (with a few exceptions) by using your student or staff card.

Loan periods can vary from 2 hours to 90 days. Most items can be renewed up to 10 times. Hourly and Overnight loans cannot be renewed and items requested via BONUS+ can only be renewed once.





