Basic Principles

- IEEE is an in-text citation style with 2 key components:
 - 1. Numbers within square brackets [1] directing the reader to the reference list.
 - 2. A numbered list of sources (Reference list) that appears at the end of the paper.
- Consistency in your citations is essential.
- **Citation numbers** should be included on the same line as the text that is being referenced, prior to any punctuation, with a space provided before the bracket. You will then use the same number for each subsequent citation of a source.
- When **citing more than one source at a time**, the preferred method is to list each reference in its own brackets, then separate with a comma or dash: [1], [3], [5] [1] [5]
- The Reference List should be ordered numerically. It only contains works used in a paper.
- **Punctuation** should be consistently applied.
- Use the Abbreviated month. Day, Year. Format for adding the date, for example: Jun. 3, 2018.
- If you are using a direct quote, you should include the page number or range
